

Directions from airport to apartment

As you walk out of the airport car rentals are opposite and slightly to the right.

Follow exit signs from the airport onto the main road.

Follow signs for Reggio Calabria. These are signed in both green and blue signs. You want the green sign SA3 Reggio Calabria.

Keep on the SA3 and take first exit to Pizzo & Vibo Marina. Look for exit road signed Tropea 522. The road goes around the base of Pizzo (which is up on the hill), be prepared for narrow roads for $\frac{1}{2}$ a mile or so.

Keep the sea on your right and stay on the 522.

At Vibo Marina the road does a little 'wobble!' It is still the 522 but when you see an Esso petrol station on your left, turn left just after it to avoid going into Vibo Marina centre and the port area. You then turn right still, on the 522 and signed Tropea and Capo Vaticano. Stay on the main road for some time (~10 miles). As you approach Tropea, you keep left and go over a new via duct, and immediately before big tunnel turn off right into what looks like a car park, signed Tropea.

Go down a very short hill and turn left at the T junction. At the next junction turn left signed to the Railway Station. You will see a railway bridge to your right which takes you to Tropea town centre.

After turning left (passing the road to the Railway Station on your right) you continue up the Mountain and take the first right after passing (left) turn to Drapia & Gasponi.

Take this, signed St. Angelo di Drapia, and 'La Pace', and after 400m there is a sign to La Pace (see photograph) that will help you identify the road. Take the second left just past the next La Pace sign.



There are some new villas at the start of this road, and as the road narrows to single track we are the second large metal gate on the right. (see photograph, there will not be a car in the drive so that you can park)



Next door to the left as you face the apartment is a plot with boulders in it where an old man often sits to chip away at them. There is often his old red fiat outside those gates. Once you have parked you will see steps behind you, go down these and walk through the first half of garden the front door is on the second covered patio!
